- Deadline for submission of the full paper (according to the requirements in Annex 2) – **30 October 2026**.
- Opportunity for remote participation via Zoom.

PUBLICATION IN CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS:

Only papers that are presented at the conference, meet the requirements and have passed the peer-review process will be published.

The proceedings will be indexed in RePEc and registered in the national reference list of NACID.
